Tamworth's Marsupial Park is a FREE ENTRY family park situated on approximately 120 acres of crown land. All daily tasks and undertakings are managed and directed by a very committed group of volunteers under a subsection 355 Council Committee, known as the Friends of Marsupial Park, which formed in 2008. Day-to-day income to maintain the park derives from the generous donations of materials and labour through the local business community in addition to cash donations from visitors to the park and funding provided by Tamworth Regional Council. *Thank you.* 

As part of plans to further improve facilities for locals and visitors, the Friends of Marsupial Park established a separate Playground Committee to oversee the bold initiative to build a regional standard children's adventure playground. 
