



Clean water, sanitation, and hygiene education are basic necessities for a healthy environment and a productive life.

When people have access to clean water and sanitation, waterborne diseases decrease, children stay healthier and attend school more regularly, and mothers can spend less time carrying water and more time helping their families.

### **HOW ROTARY MAKES HELP HAPPEN**

Through water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) programs, Rotary's people of action mobilize resources, form partnerships, and invest in infrastructure and training

that yield long-term change.







### **MAKING SCHOOLS HEALTHIER**

All 24 of Lebanon's Rotary clubs came together — overcoming religious, cultural, and political divisions — to form partnerships with the government, World Vision, UNICEF, and the Red Cross. Together the groups developed a program that delivers clean water to every public school in the country.

### **WATER FOR A COMMUNITY**

Rotary clubs partnered with local organizations to install a rainwater harvesting and distribution centre for 4,000 people in Madan, India. They also delivered training programs for women in the community and students in 35 schools.

### **ACCESS TO TOILETS IN THE PHILIPPINES**

Rotary clubs and partners built 222 toilets, six rainwater collectors, seven communal handwashing stations, and 20 bio sand filters. The project provided more than 1,000 people with access to proper toilet facilities and almost 600 people with a regular supply of clean water.




