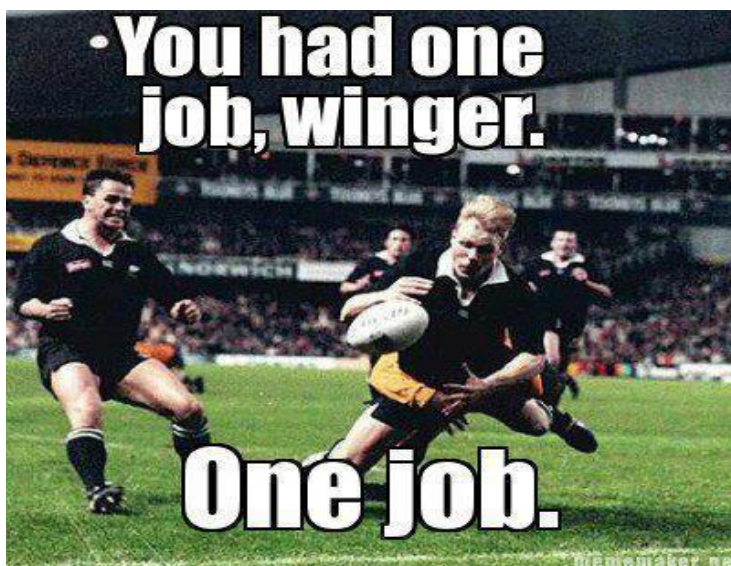

'I have a marvelous instrument designed to be used on a woman, but which is, to date, unused.'

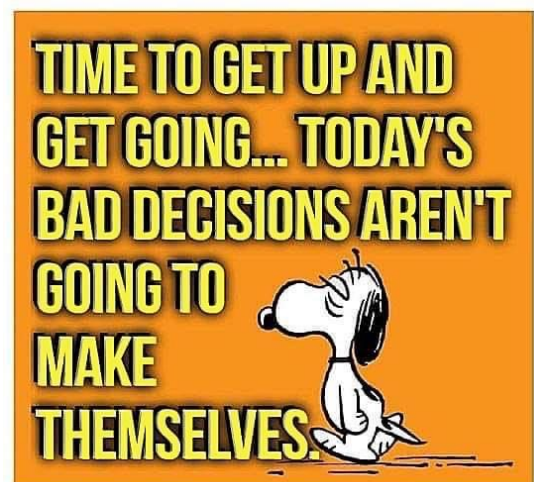
Roaring with laughter, the official said, 'Go ahead, Father. Next please!'

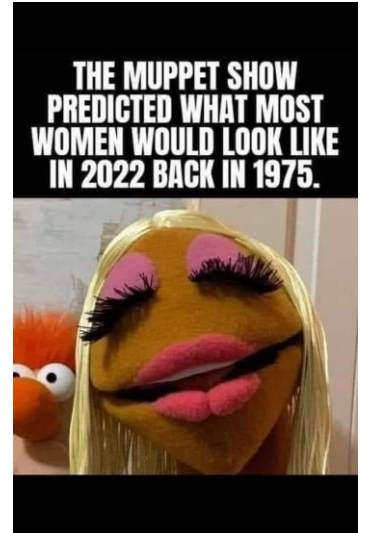
