


















Guest Speaker Notes - Mark Chapple

Mark spoke to us regarding his involvement with assisting Ukrainians to reach Australia. As you can imagine this process has been long and arduous and continues to fight uphill battles.

"To provide a "Brief" on our "Project" my wife Jenni and I have supported 8 Ukrainians into Australia, and numerous others who arrived here and needed advice / assistance / a pathway to establishing a stable life in Australia.

We see that Regional Living has a lot to offer - Jobs are aplenty, and the Lifestyle is certainly more affordable than our bigger cities such as Sydney and Melbourne. Our biggest obstacles have been language (for some) and lack of Accommodation in pretty much every regional town or city. It is a very real problem.

Below are Yurii and Inna, they are the first couple we supported to Australia on 25th March, only 28 days following the Russian Federation Invasion on Ukraine.

Rather than detail here what he spoke of, I have attached the pdf he has provided which shares their story.




