


### Rotary Club of Tamworth - NSW Australia 4 d . O

### **Oral Health and How it All Fits**

Michael's parents originate from Germany. His dad became a GP in Australia. Michael was educated in Singleton, was a Science teacher for all of 5 minutes through Newcsatle Uni, then moved into his Dentistry Degree in Sydney. He worked at Chesterhill, then North Rocks. Eventually he bought a practice in Gunnedah in 1986, working until 2017 when he retired for a short period and now has a practice here in Tamworth. In 2002 he became a member of the Dental Association and last year was the President. His hobbies include motorcycling, flying, referring and coaching rugby union and travelling.

- Bad Oral Health: Decay, Gum Disease, Soft Tissue Disease.
- Dentistry spends most of their time preventing diseases
- The mouth is a horrible place to work full of bacteria, humid, wet
- Life expectancy drops if mouth health is poor
- Significant causes of poor mouth health: Sugar, Tobacco, Polypharmacy (medication)
- The bacteria in your mouth can cause medical issues
- GOOD TEETH = GOOD HEALTH
- To help with good mouth hygiene: reduce sugar consumption, education
