Julia Boland – Professional Golfer and Head of Senior Secondary at Calrossy, Brisbane Street Campus

Julia grew up in Tamworth being the youngest of 4 children. She attended Carinya Christian School through K-12.

Her father was a keen golfer, and always wanted the kids to be involved in sport and being living an active and healthy lifestyle. Julia joined the "subbies" at Tamworth Golf Club and the professional, Terry Hayes took her under his wing and so commenced her golfing career.

Julia believes not so much in being "gifted and talented" as just hard work. Practise, practise, practise and being fortunate to have people support and help her along the way. Julia played in a number of amateur golfing events in Australia winning the Australian Women's Amateur Stroke Play in 2009. She won the Karrie Webb Scholarship which was the start of a strong friendship with the Australian champion, and turned professional in 2011.

Julia played in the US on the LGPA for 7 years with mixed success and found a strong appreciation for what pressure and stress are really like....missing putts for \$28,000 aren't forgotten easily!

After suffering a hip injury and numerous surgeries, Julia returned home to Australia and is now enjoying her role as Head of Brisbane Street Campus at Calrossy. She loves the input she can have on young people in teaching them and having them own their own decisions.

Interestingly, Julia believes golf is a simple game....one only needs to "control the mind". Simple.
