
Sporting a brand new suntan, Magic is back in Tamworth for the school holidays.

GUEST SPEAKER- MARTIN RAE - NORTHERN INLAND ACADEMY OF SPORT (NIAS) V2.0

Coach Martin was back again, doing his best impersonation of the coach from Guy Ritchie's 2019 film, The Gentlemen. The resemblance is uncanny. Oh, and he was also talking to us about training our regional kids in the world game- Football.

Martin has now been in Australia 22 weeks, and has hit the ground running in his role with the Northern Inland Academy of Sport (NIAS). A bit of a change from Scotland, I bet.

The NIAS program coaches kids from 8-15yrs from a Skills Acquisition phase program through to a junior development league, and up to regional and state competition circuit. There are 200 kids in the program taking part in local games, gala days, and Saturday play, with additional requirements of bi-weekly training, 2-3 coaching sessions per week, along with all the other great things team sport can bring to the kids. Things such as time management, public speaking, social skills, life skills, good exercise, and discipline etc.

Martin likens his role as coach to that of a educator, social worker, parent liaison, psychologist, and mediator between the NIAS and the federation administration functions of the sport.

Martin notes key differences in Australian football (Soccer) and the Scottish system being the bottom up fundint that Australian football has- meaning that there is little support from the federation in helping to fund the progression of sportspeople at a grass roots level. There is also a lack of an 'exit strategy' for players who progress through the ranks, but don't make the cut for the premier teams...

Overall Martin believes that "there is so much opportunity showing in the children of our region" and looks to develop our athletes through his role.






