Tickets are available at \$5 each with a first prize of \$2000 for the winning ticket. Each \$5 ticket sold will represent 5km virtually walked and will be added to the Walkabout Tally. The

Walkabout Tally will be adjusted regularly and plotted on an accompanying map. The updates including the Map and total raised will be shared on the District 9660 Facebook page and in the District newsletter.

What a great way to get out into the sunshine and keep the step-count up, while helping the RSPCA at the same time.


The aim is to walk 56km to help reduce the 56,000 animal abuse complaints received by RSPCA each year.






