Very topical at present is Medication Shortages. This is not entirely new for pharmacy and is part of the post pandemic new normal.

Three factor causation being Pandemic; Geopolitical instability and Climate Change.

Globalisation has limited manufacturers and locations of product at all stages. Some products pass through five countries before production is complete (raw ingredient to Packaged consumer product).

Thank you Ruth for an interesting and informative presentation.


